## School Choice Update

Public School Choice is a provision of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB). Under this provision, your child was eligible for Public School Choice and for qualifying students, Supplemental Educational Services (SES) for the 2012-13 school year. We do not know yet whether Public School Choice or SES will continue to be an option for the 2013-14 school year. The State has asked for a waiver to many of the provisions of NCLB including no longer mandating School Choice and Supplemental Education Services. You will be notified by U.S. mail early in July, 2013 if your child will be eligible
