Its great if you buy food in bulk for your family or for entertaining.</p>	<p>Pick up an application form from the PTA, or at the GFS register when you check out. When you shop, just show your card for the donation to be applied.</p>

Rt. 59 Aurora</p>	<p>Up to 4% donation to the school (some exclusions apply)</p>	<p>Through the use of the Meijer Guest Card, which you can scan at the register, Meijer makes a contribution to the school that costs you nothing. The more you shop, the more we earn.</p>	<p>Sign up online or at the Meijer Customer Service desk; you'll receive a card in the mail. When you check out, scan your card and a percentage of your purchase is credited to the school.</p>
<p>Target 1951 W. Jefferson Naperville</p>	<p>Donations total 1% of purchases at Target and Target.com, and 1/2% of purchases made with a Target® Visa</p>	<p>Apply for and use your Target Visa or Target Card to make purchases at Target, or anyplace else where Visa is accepted. To date, our school has earned almost \$3,000 in donations from Target!</p>	<p>Target Visa, Target Card and eligible Target Business Card accounts can sign up for the Take Charge of Education program by calling 1-800-316-6142 or by visiting Target.com; our school ID# is 48669.</p>
